Hearing and Vision Screening Time Again

To All Parents of Kindergarteners, 4th Graders, and New Students of Meadow Hall this school year: It is extremely important that students be able to hear and see properly in order to learn. Because of this Hearing and Vision is tested on students in the above mentioned grades each year. We always find several students who need glasses or hearing intervention.

This year the dates for the testing are Thursday, February 1 and Friday, February 2. In order to have the students properly tested it is important that anyone who ALREADY wears glasses bring these to school to be tested with them on. This will enable the examiner to determine if a new prescription is needed. Should the student come without glasses, the need for an exam will be decided which could mean an unnecessary trip to the optometrist (or ophthalmologist) for you parents.

If you can help transport kids back and forth from their classes for the tests or if you feel there is a problem with your student's vision or hearing, please let Mrs. Parreco in the Health Room know before January 26. -Thank you, JoAnne Banda, RN, SCHN
