Morning Reading Club Schedule:

Meadow Hall will initiate a Morning Reading Club-from @ 8:20 to 8:50 (Kindergarten time will be 8:30 to 8:50). Students from the different grade levels will meet under the guidance of the Reading Specialist for a book talk, independent reading, sharing, and advice on 'Just Right Books. This is a voluntary club available to any interested students and would create an organized academic activity during the time students would normally be waiting in the hallway for the bell to ring. An announcement will be made 5 minutes prior to the time to remind students the grade level, the time, and the place that the club will meet that day.
